

Creative Concept Final Project

Based on the annotations you've developed in your second paper, this project is designed so students can begin to 'imagine' an active solution to some of the problems addressed in the class. In class we have redefined the role of the artist from someone who creates objects for self-expression to one who is viewed as facilitator, encouraging others as creators and producers. We have also seen artists who create socially motivated art as a kind of advocacy to bring attention to various social problems.

In this creative concept project you become the designer—the artist. Your project presentation will include:

Clear and well-organized **description** of a Social Art Project related to our subject.

Rationale— The reason for this particular project.

How and who does it help? Why this is important? Give information about how it might help the population involved and what it might do for society in general.

Intention—What you hope to accomplish and how?

Using all the readings, lectures, websites we have reviewed in class, together with those discovered in your own research, you will write this as a paper and be prepared to present your idea in class.

You will produce a paper and presentation for the class that clearly discusses your idea.
