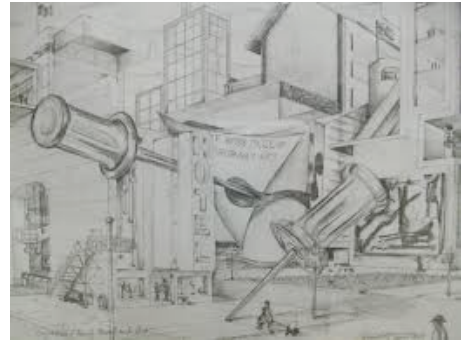


Perspective: Grade sheet.

The mid-week update reminded you that in class I asked you to work with multiple perspective in your homework drawing. This means your drawing should have more than one perspective represented in the one drawing.

Be Very Specific with your Answers. This is designed to measure how well you understand, can speak about, and apply concepts to your work.



Line: (how does your drawing make use of line?)

Value: Does your drawing use value? How and why?

Composition: (how have you used the space in your drawing? Is there a balanced or dynamic use of positive vs. negative space? Have you arranged the elements in a way that makes use of the edges or does this matter?)

Perspective: (What type of perspective is used? Are elements in the drawing shown in perspective or are they flat? Is the perspective believable even as you have integrated more than one perspective?)

Overall: (Have you created an interesting drawing? In what way is it interesting? Is it the subject matter? Skill? Creative use of the concept? Other?)

Risk: Discuss how your choices indicate some risk on your part?
