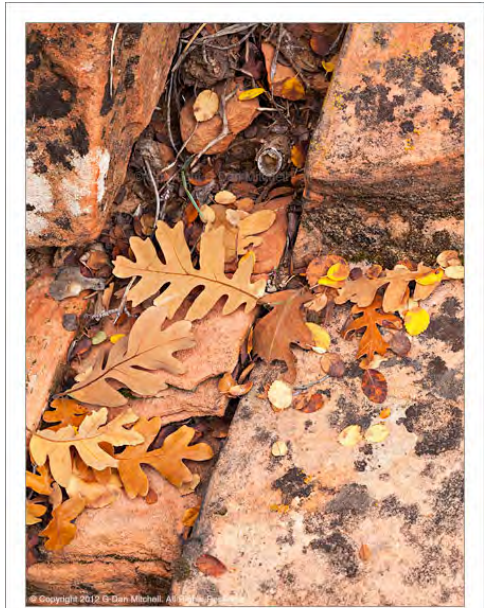
Assignment Detritus

We have been working on photographs with consideration of Design Elements. Last week you should have had photos that serve as examples of Unity/Variety, Emphasis, or Scale/Proportion.

This week you are shooting at least 25 photos of things that fall into the category of Detritus. Read the definition I gave or do more research.

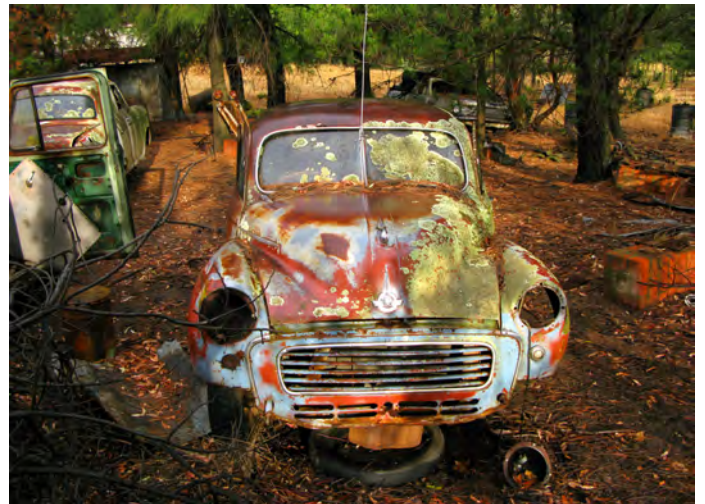
The Design Element you are working with is Balance.

We talked about several types of balance (which you can see again on the website if necessary). As with all photos you will need to talk about your image and what kind of balance we see.



Here are some suggestions for photographing:

1. shoot at least 25 images
2. shoot three or more angles of the same shot. Think about getting the camera down low to shoot from the ground, or position yourself above your subject and shoot down. We tend to see and take photos from the same viewing position and a unique viewing position can be really helpful for creating more interesting images.
3. Keep in mind the other design elements we covered.
4. Think about balance and how you are working with balance in your shot.



For every project you will submit a folder to Google. By the deadline, February 25 you should have work for these projects:

1. Design Elements-- Design Elements 1: contact sheets from 2 weeks (2 for each week), original photo, edited final photo, self-evaluation sheet. Design Element 2: 1 week (1 contact sheet for each design element), original, edited final photo, self-analysis sheet.
 2. Detritus-- 2 contact sheets, original photo, edited final photo, self-analysis sheet.
- Make sure your self-eanalysis indicates understanding the concept and balance.
