Set Image resolution at the highest your camera will allow. TIFF or RAW is best.

Set Mode for type of picture.

Find the Light:

- 1. time of day
- 2. weather
- 3. direction
- 4. color
- 5. creativity

Shoot from unexpected angles

Zoom in on your subject

Get the right exposure by setting the shutter speed if possible.

Reduce background clutter.

Follow the rule of thirds.

Avoid mergers or tangents.

Look for balance.

Keep the horizon straight.

Frame the subject.

Create a mood.

Name file with last name and date.
