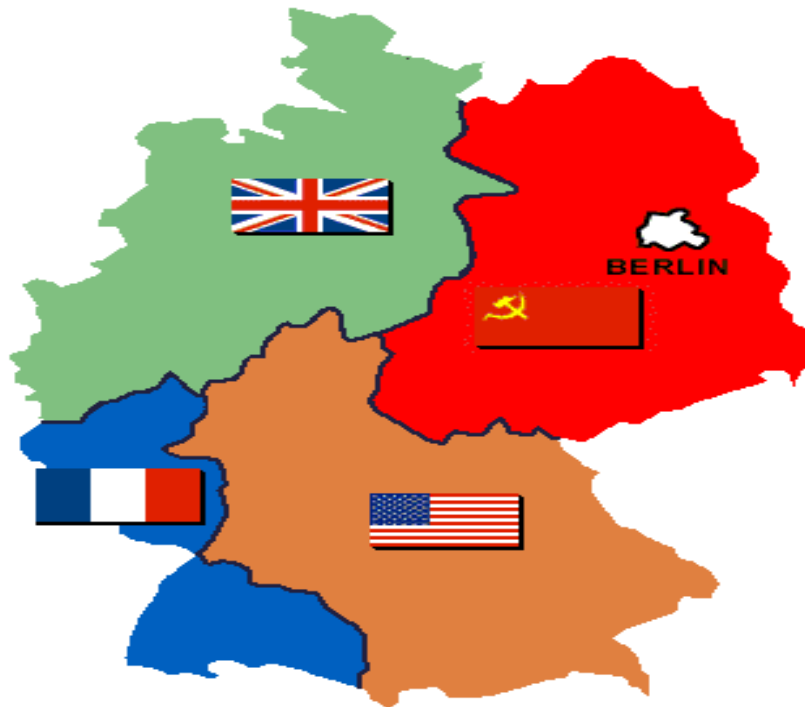

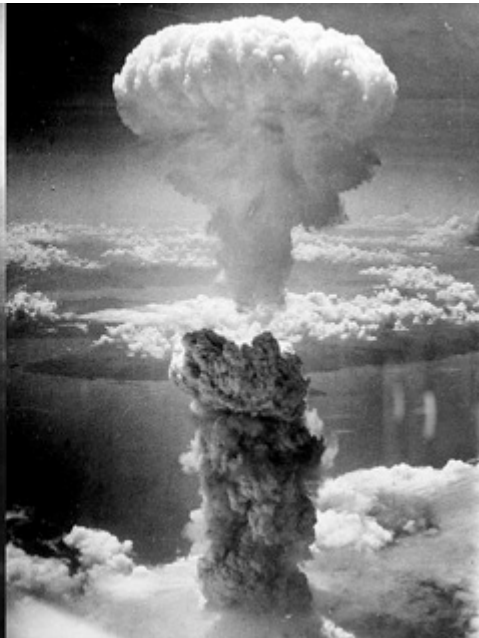
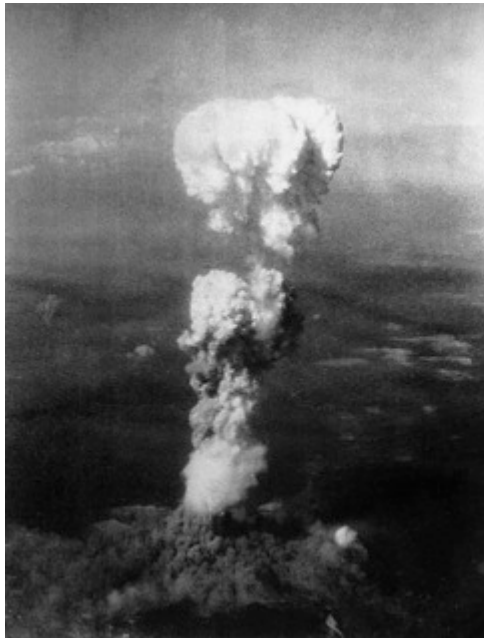
# Conference at Yalta

- Meeting with the leaders of “The Big Three” of the Allied forces
- Divided Germany into four sections
- United Nations Security Council



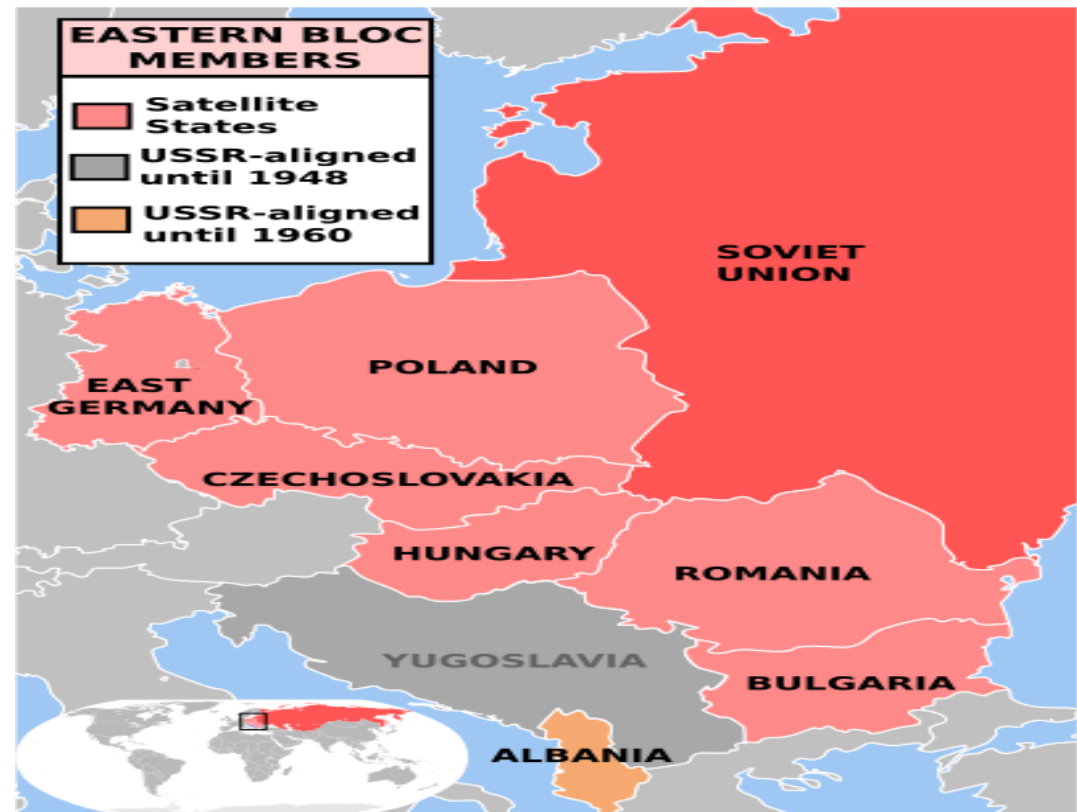
# Potsdam Conference

- President Harry Truman takes over after the death of Franklin D. Roosevelt
- Germany is disarmed and dismantled
- Japan is threatened with “prompt and utter destruction”



# Post War Europe

- Separation of Allied forces results in a different separation of Germany
- The Soviet Union begins forming the Eastern Block



# “Start” of the Cold War

- Stalin tried to force the US troops out of Western Germany resulting in the Berlin Airlifts
- Formation of NATO and the Warsaw Pact
