Student Choice**

Write a clear description of your finished painting: include the subject matter and why this mattered to you. Tell the artist you used as a guide. Discuss their style, what you learned using the style and why this style made sense for your subject.

If you copied a master painting, tell artist, title, size, style and why you chose it and what you learned.

Write on the back or on another sheet, answers to the points listed to the left. Then use this scale from 1 as lowest to 5 as highest. If the objective listed does not apply to your work, just leave blank.

Then, say how your painting indicates these objectives:

- learn to use oil paint as a media
 - techniques to mix color 1 2 3 4 5
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 - techniques to blend color 1 2 3 4 5
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 - techniques to create shadows 1 2 3 4 5
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- learn to pay close attention to reference (in this case your photo and/or master painting).
 - have you matched image 1 2 3 4 5
 - have you matched color 1 2 3 4 5
 - have you matched style 1 2 3 4 5
- learn various brushstrokes to create texture 1 2 3 4 5
- learn process for drawing and painting a larger painting 1 2 3 4 5
